- Originality of idea
- Clarity and effectiveness of presentation
- Quality of writing
- Significance of the contribution to the field
- Dissertation must have been submitted and approved during calendar year 2023 or defended in fall 2023 and approved before the nomination deadline
- Only one nomination per department or interdisciplinary degree program
- Secured dissertations are not eligible

NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS/CHECKLIST

- Completed nomination form
- Double-spaced summary (maximum 2 pages) written by nominee so that reviewers outside the field can gain insight into contribution
- One-page nomination letter from major professor addressing all selection criteria and including nominee's current position, if applicable
- One-page support letter from another member of dissertation committee
- Curriculum vitae from nominee (maximum 2 pages)
