Resolution to Incorporate an Inclusion and Diversity Education Component into Graduate Education

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The Materials Science and Engineering Department will incorporate an Inclusion and Diversity Education Component (IDEC) into its graduate curriculum (per Resolution 2017-18A of the Commission on Graduate Studies and Policies) through the following mechanisms:

- 1. All incoming graduate students will be required to complete within their first two semesters in residence the Engineering Education course, ENGE 5304 "Graduate Student Success Multicultural Environments." This is a one credit P/F course that is currently offered every Fall and Spring. Continuing students who already had an approved Plan of Study in place prior to Spring 2022 but need a new Plan of Study due to a change in degree type will meet this requirement by completing the mandatory University training module on Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion. They must provide a certificate of completion to the MSE Graduate Coordinator, who will indicate the completion of the IDEC Requirement on the student's new Plan of Study.
- 2. As an alternate to mechanism 1, students may take GRAD 5214 "Diversity for Global Society," a three credit course.

The MSE Graduate Coordinator will indicate the completion of the IDEC Requirement on the student's Plan of Study.
